RURAL HEALTH CLINIC KIDMED PROGRAM



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Each kid med visit is required to include medically necessary services. EPSDT is made up of the following screening, diagnostic, and treatment services:

Each child is a special, unique person who needs special care. We offer full Pediatric Services such as:

- Child Wellness Exams
- Immunizations
- Developmental Screenings
- Nutrition Assessment
- Dental Assessment
- Vision & Hearing Exams
- Blood & Urine Checks
- Health Education

We provide KidMed services to Medicaid eligible children ages 0 to 21.

EPSDT

Children who are enrolled in Medicaid are eligible to receive EPSDT services.

- **Early:** Assessing and identifying problems early
- **Periodic:** Checking children's health at periodic, age-appropriate intervals
- **Screening:** Providing physical, mental, developmental, dental, hearing, vision, and other screening tests to detect potential problems.
- **Diagnostic:** Performing diagnostic tests to follow up when a risk is identified, and
- **Treatment:** Control, correct or reduce health problems found.

- Comprehensive health and developmental history
- Comprehensive unclothed physical exam
- Age appropriate immunizations
- Laboratory tests (including anemia and lead toxicity screening)
- Health Education (anticipatory guidance including child development, healthy lifestyle, and accident & disease prevention)
- Vision and Hearing screenings
- Dental exams
- Necessary referrals for any further evaluation based on above screenings
